

**Instructions for:  
Transforming a Photograph into a Silhouette Graphic**

- 1) Press: Command + J = Make a copy of the layer
- 2) Press: Command + Shift + U = Remove all color
- 3) Press: Command + Shift + L = Apply auto levels
- 4) Click on the Quick Mask Icon (Bottom of primary tool bar)
- 5) Use the Pencil Tool to outline your subject
- 6) Use the Paint Bucket to Fill the Subject (Quick Mask)
- 7) Press: "Q" to make the Quick Mask into a selection
- 8) Press: Command + Delete = To fill outside of the selection
- 9) Press: Command + "D" = Unselects the selection
- 10) Image > Adjustments > Posterize | Levels: 2
- 11) Filter > Noise > Median (Adjust to taste)
  - i) [Repeat again to clear up = Shift + F]
- 12) Create an Inside Border = fX Button (Adjust to taste)
- 13) Go to the Channels Tab, Click on the Dotted Circle
- 14) Go to the Layer Tab, Click on the Create New Layer Button to create a new layer
- 15) Press: Command + Shift + I = Invert the Selection
- 16) Add a Gradient to the Silhouette
- 17) Go to the Layer Tab:
  - i) Press: Command and the New Layer Button to create a layer below
  - ii) Fill the background layer with a color
- 18) Add A Type/Text Title
